The trip will depart from Manchester airport over October half term 2025 when pupils in the current year 8 will be in year 10 and those currently in year 9 will be in year 11. Half term dates are yet to be confirmed but we are likely to be flying out on Sunday 15th and return on Saturday 23rd October. You will be responsible for getting your son to the airport and picking them up upon their return. Exact timings and itinerary will be confirmed nearer the time of departure.

<u>Cost</u>

The cost of the trip will be £2675 payable in 6 instalments. This covers all travel (except to and from Manchester airport), accommodation and all meals whilst on the trip. Unfortunately, there will be an additional charge of £88.00 APD (Air Passenger Duty) tax charged per passenger aged 16 that may affect some of the older pupils in year 9.

We wish to make it clear that if the visit takes place, no student will be denied participation on the grounds that no contribution has been made on their behalf. However, please be aware, if insufficient contributions are made we will be unable to proceed with the trip.
