French Language study immersion trip, Nice. 5th – 11th October 2025.

Dear Parent/Carer

Following the success of last year's exciting French Language study and immersion trip opportunity to Nice in France with Blue Stamp Travel we are delighted to offer this opportunity again. Blue Stamp Travel specialise in work experience and language courses abroad. This experience is open to those students currently in Years 10-12 who will be studying French in September 2025. Places are extremely limited to 19, prioritising the current Year 12, current Year 11 and then current Year 10.

Students will be immersed in the French language through following an intensive language course in the Alpha B language school and daily life activities. Each morning will be spent in the Language school where students will follow a tailored course for their age and ability.

The course is certificated at the end and students will return more confident in speaking French. Students will enjoy and gain invaluable cultural experience and knowledge first hand through the organised visits. The accommodation is carefully selected by Blue Stamp Travel and we will be staying at the hotel / hostel Villa Saint Exupéry Beach on a Bed and Breakfast basis. Students will therefore need money for lunch and the evening meal - options to be explained later on. We will have planned cultural visits in the afternoons. These will include, Nice itself, Monaco and Antibes. All visits are included in the cost of the trip.

Travel:

Dates 5th - 11th October

Easyjet Flight: Liverpool – Nice 5th October, Nice - Liverpool 11th October.

Blue Stamp Travel are both ABTA and ATOL bonded and have knowledgeable and multilingual staff (including ex-teachers) who are available to help and advise students, teachers and parents before and during their stay as necessary.

Cost

If 16-19 students apply for the trip the cost will be £1200 (Students will purchase lunch and dinner each day). The <u>non-refundable deposit</u> of £300 (dependent upon the number of students applying for the trip) will be <u>due immediately upon request to secure a place</u>.

The interim payment of £300 will be due by Thursday 1st May.
Then a payment of £300 will be due by Thursday 26th June.
The final payment of £300 will be due by Monday 8th September.

• The cost will reduce by £50 if 20 pupils participate in the trip.

We wish to make it clear that if the visit takes place, no student will be denied participation on the grounds that no contribution has been made on their behalf. However, please be aware, if insufficient contributions are made, we will be unable to proceed with the trip.
